Biography

Kevin grew up in Clinton, New York, attending the Stone Presbyterian Church. He attended Houghton College, in Houghton, New York, where he earned a B.S. degree in 1978 with majors in Bible and Christian Education. He then went to Trinity Evangelical Divinity School, in Deerfield, Illinois, where he earned an M.A. degree in Christian Education in 1981. During his studies, Kevin's focus was primarily on camping and retreat ministries, but God used an experience of serving as an interim instructor at Houghton College for a year (1979-1980) to call him to serve in the church. Following his Masters studies, Kevin served as a Minister of Christian Education in three different congregations. From 1981-1983 he served at Bethel Evangelical Free Church, in North Platte, Nebraska. From 1983-1986 he served at St. John's United Methodist Church, in Turnersville, New Jersey. From 1986-1992 he served at Columbia Street Baptist Church in Bangor, Maine. During his years in New Jersey, Kevin began a Ph.D. program in educational psychology. Upon moving to Maine, this program of study was not available nearby, so he pursued and completed an Ed.D. in educational administration. In this program at the University of Maine, Orono, he had freedom to focus his studies on the church's educational work. His dissertation was on career patterns of Ministers of Christian Education, with a focus on why some left this field of service.

Following the completion of his doctoral degree in 1992, Kevin served as Assistant Professor, and later Associate Professor of Christian Education at Canadian Theological Seminary, in Regina, Saskatchewan, Canada, until 1995 (this school later moved to Calgary, Alberta, Canada, and is now known as Ambrose University College and Seminary). At that time he accepted an invitation to teach at Talbot School of Theology, Biola University, in La Mirada, California. He has served as Director of the doctoral programs in the field of Christian education at Talbot since 1999, and in 2003 he became editor of the *Christian Education Journal* when it came to Talbot.

He and his wife, Patty, were married in 1979 and have three grown children. She teaches flute lessons and plays in several musical organizations. They enjoy travel, hiking, reading, and spending time with their children and friends.

Your research and interest fields (short description)

Kevin’s primarily research interests include: the history of the church’s educational ministry efforts (with particular interest in the medieval period and the 20th century), children’s spirituality, theological foundations and issues in Christian education, church staff development and support, effective teaching research, and current changes in the field of Christian education.

Current projects (short summary)

At this time, Kevin is working with a colleague (Mick Boersma) to revise and update his 2000 publication, *How to Thrive in Associate Staff Ministry* (Alban Institute). He is also working on a series of articles on how lay people learned the faith in the medieval period, possibly leading to a book on this topic. He is working with other colleagues on proposals for a new text on the history of Christian religious education, and one on teaching the Bible for deeper impact. He is also currently heading up a task force within the Society of Professors in Christian Education studying core curriculum issues for programs in this field.

Within the next year or so he hopes to finish the *Christian Educators of the 20th Century* web-based database project, funded by the Lilly Endowment. This project, which began in 2001, provides biographical essays, assessments of contributions, and bibliographies on approximately 200 Christian religious education leaders of the 20th century who have impacted the field in North America.
